

WILD SCENE INVESTIGATION

EPISODE 1: GHOST ON THE GREEN (Lilly Brook Golf Course – Gloucestershire)

Vandals have been on the rampage at a golf course in the west of England, but who or what could dig over 200 holes in a single night, and why would they want to? The 17th green is a mess; it's been closed for several months while the grounds men try to repair the damage. And the 16th fairway has its own problems, with enough holes to make parts of it unplayable. With no idea as to what could be doing it and no solution on how to stop it, the club is desperate for help. It's the perfect job for the Wild Scene Investigators.

EPISODE 2: Monster of the Manor (Iford Manor, Bath)

Mysterious sightings of a big cat are being reported in the heart of the British countryside, but could there really be a potential man eater on the loose, or could there be there another explanation? Picturesque Iford Manor in the heart of rural Wiltshire is the perfect setting for an Agatha Christie novel. For the last fifteen years it's been a hotspot for sightings of an animal that shouldn't be here. Everyone from the Lady of the Manor, to the head gardener and the gamekeeper has seen the mysterious beast, and all are certain that this visitor is a melanistic big cat. Could so many credible witnesses all be wrong? And if they're not, how did a big cat get here?

EPISODE 3 HAUNTED FOREST (Pembury Woods, Wales)

Strange sounds and spooky sightings are giving locals a fright. Could a coastal forest in Wales, Britain be haunted by ship-wreckers or is the local wildlife just coming out at night? Armed with camera traps and gadgets the fun-filled WSI team set out to catch the culprits. The British Isles are well known for their haunted locations, Pembrey Forest is no exception. Three hundred years ago wreckers used to lure ships onto the sands and whisk away their booty through the forest. Now strange sounds and ghostly lanterns are thought to pervade the forest at night so there is only one thing for it a member of the WSI team must spend a night alone in the forest, an ideal time for ghostly tricks!

EPISODE 4 Goat Sucking Ghoul

A story of a bizarre blue-eyed hairless dog local's call the Chupacabra is putting the terror into Texas. Are the sceptics right and locals are misidentifying a mangy coyotes? The fun filled WSI team meets famous Texan hospitality and think they know what animal they are looking for but if it is not simply a coyote with mange what is it's true nature; An undiscovered species? A weird cross bred dog? Or could it be the mythical and infamous Chupacabra or 'Goat Sucker'? Armed with the latest gadgets and camera traps our team set

out to catch the creature on camera and once for all determine the true nature of this strange animal. The stakes are high but can they vindicate the locals and get the scientific community behind them? The investigation results surprise the team themselves!

EPISODE 5 Crooks in the Canyon

EPISODE 7 Killer Cat Thief

In the sleepy town of Jericho the word "Fisher" is on every cat owner's lips. Many claim they have heard it screaming at night, yet few have seen the animal, let alone seen it attack a cat. EPISODE 8 Dog Snatcher
