To succeed, he will rely on the ancient techniques of indigenous people who have lived in these environments for thousands of years. In adventures that will take him to the parched sands of the Australian desert, the storm-ridden waters of the West Pacific, and the barren freezing wastes of North East Canada, Hazen will be pushed to the limit by his environment and answer the killer question – how does anyone survive here?

LONG: Hazen Audel, survival instructor and wilderness guide, is travelling to some of the most extreme places on the planet to take on solo challenges that will push him to the limit of his knowledge, endurance and skills. To succeed, he will rely on the ancient techniques of indigenous people who have lived in these environments for thousands of years.

In the western Pacific Hazen embarks on a huge ocean journey in a tiny traditional boat called a “tatala”. Battling powerful ocean currents and violent tropical storms, Hazen must dig deep to make it to the fishing grounds, and catch a big fish, to prove to the Tao tribe that he is worth of their respect.

In the sun-scorched desert centre of Australia, Hazen treks through the barren wilderness in search of a new waterhole. In every direction are more and more things that could kill him, from venomous snakes and deadly spiders to freezing night temperatures and bush fires.

In Mexico Hazen takes on a treacherous run through the mountainous chasms of Copper Canyon. In the way of the Tarahumara, Hazen runs with nothing on his feet but leather sandals, and must navigate precarious cliffs, raging rivers and violent thunderstorms.

The deserts of northern Namibia are home to the Himba tribe, and using their survival techniques Hazen takes on a huge journey, leading cattle through the wilderness as a gift

from one village to another. Battling dehydration in the arid dunes, Hazen must deal with dangerous animals large and small, from venomous snakes, to a pack of herd elephants.

In Indonesia Hazen joins two young shamen on a traditional hunt for a python in the dense jungles of Siberut Island. But he has to find them first, negotiating the danger ridden path from the village alone. The intense heat and humidity, along with vegetation laden with snakes, scorpions and spiders will test Hazen to his limits.

In the frozen wilds of North East Canada, Hazen is sent on a mission by the Cree people – to locate the migrating caribou herds and send word back to the elders so that they can begin their annual caribou hunt. Hampered by some of the coldest weather on Earth and by the treacherous icy landscape, Hazen will find this one of the toughest tracking challenges of his life.

JUNGLE SACRIFICE

INDONESIA (THE MENTAWAI PEOPLE)

SHORT: Hazen Audel embarks on a punishing journey through the thick jungle island of Siberut.

MEDIUM: Hazen Audel sets off on a gruelling mission through the dense jungles of Siberut Island to join a band of tribal hunters on a ritualistic pig hunt.

LONG: Hazen Audel takes on a challenging trek through the remote jungles of Siberut Island, Indonesia. Negotiating deadly snakes and monsoon rains, he'll join an elite band of tribal hunters and stalk a wild pig required for a spiritualistic house building ceremony. His success depends on the ancient survival knowledge of the shamanistic Mentawai tribe and Hazen will be pushed to the edge of his strength and skill in this jungle sacrifice.

DEADLY DESERT

NAMIBIA (THE HIMBA PEOPLE OF KAOKOLAND)

SHORT: Hazen Audel takes on a punishing trek through the blistering deserts of northern Namibia.

MEDIUM: Hazen Audel sets off on a punishing trek through the scorched deserts of northern Namibia and delivers a sacred gift to a tribe in the barren dunes.

LONG: Hazen Audel embarks on a gruelling trek through the deserts of Northern Namibia and delivers a sacred gift to a tribe who live in the barren dunes. He'll be pushed to the edge of endurance by blistering heat and virtually no water surrounded by some of the deadliest animals in Africa. Armed with the unique survival skills of the striking Himba tribe, Hazen will see if he's got what it takes to survive the deadly desert.

OUTBACK INFERNO

AUSTRALIA (WESTERN ARANDA PEOPLE)

SHORT: Hazen Audel ventures into the sun-scorched Australian outback in search of a desert lake.

MEDIUM: Hazen Audel embarks on an epic endurance challenge into the sun-ravaged Australian outback in search of a hidden freshwater oasis.

LONG: Hazen Audel ventures into the unforgiving and sun-ravaged Australian outback in search of a hidden freshwater oasis. On this epic endurance challenge, our determined survivalist will face blistering heat and some of the most deadly creatures in the world, in a land with almost no water. But armed with the skills and weapons of the region's Aboriginal people, Hazen will see if he has what it takes to unlock the secrets of the desert and survive this desert inferno.

HOSTILE CANYON

MEXICO (THE RARAMURI PEOPLE OF COPPER CANYON)

SHORT: Hazen Audel faces lethal animals, vertical cliffs and impossible terrain on a deadly run.

MEDIUM: Hazen Audel takes on a deadly solo run into the deepest canyon in North America. Lethal animals, vertical cliffs and soaring temperatures await.

LONG: Hazen Audel, survival instructor and wilderness guide, is travelling to some of the most extreme places on the planet to take on solo challenges that will push him to the limit of his knowledge, endurance and skills. To succeed, he will rely on the ancient techniques of indigenous people who have lived in these environments for thousands of years. In adventures that will take him to the parched sands of the Australian desert, the storm-ridden waters of the West Pacific, and the barren freezing wastes of North East Canada, Hazen will be pushed to the limit by his environment and answer the killer question – how does anyone survive here?

KILLER SEAS

TAIWAN (THE TAO PEOPLE OF PONGSO NO TAO)

SHORT: Hazen Audel embarks on a perilous ocean voyage in the hope of catching a huge fish.

MEDIUM: Hazen Audel embarks on a perilous solo voyage, facing deadly ocean currents and raging storms to reach traditional fishing grounds in the Pacific.

LONG: In the seething waters of a remote volcanic island of Pongso No Tao, Hazen sets out on an epic ocean journey in a tiny traditional wooden boat called a tatala. Following in the wake of the remarkable Tao people who fish these inhospitable waters, Hazen braves treacherous tropical seas on a quest to reach the deep water where ocean giants feed, there to catch a prized big fish and prove his manhood.

KILLER BLIZZARD

CANADA (THE CREE NATION OF CHISASIBI)

SHORT: Hazen Audel tracks a caribou herd across the deadly frozen wilds of Northern Canada.

MEDIUM: Hazen Audel is on a gruelling mission to locate a herd of caribou in the deadly frozen wilds of Canada's sub-arctic boreal forest.

LONG: Hazen Audel is on a gruelling mission through the deadly frozen wilds of Northern Canada, on a search for a herd of migratory caribou. In one of his most challenging missions ever, he faces lethal temperatures way below zero, howling blizzards and treacherous icy

river crossings in a land roamed by packs of wolves. Pushed to the limits of human endurance, he must rely on the skills of the James Bay Cree to survive on this punishing journey.
